Guided ITE Art tour in Päijät-Häme Departure from Saaristenkatu 5, Hämeenlinna

Guided outsider art tour to ITE Art environments and other attractions in Päijät-Häme. Bus tour starts at 9 am from Saaristenkatu 5, Hämeenlinna. There will be two busses, which will visit same attractions in different order. In addition, the bus 1 will go through the Lahti Travel Centre (Mannerheiminkatu 15) at 01:35 pm.

Tour includes two warm meals: lunch at Kelossi restaurant and dinner at Kaarisilta. The lunch break of bus 1 will be at 11:35am-12:30pm and bus 2 at 12:15-01:00pm. The tour ends into the beautiful garden of Kaarisilta and then back to Hämeenlinna, where we are around 7 pm.

TOUR STOPS

Esa Pajulahti's Promised Land

One of the great discoveries of the ITE art survey in Häme is Esa Pajulahti's art environment, the Promised Land, an entire village of skilfully executed constructions commenting on the ways of the world. The productive master of the house, a retired carpenter, has also built a fantastically beautiful forest church on top of a hill.

Enni Id's artist home

Enni Id's home, ornately painted from floor to ceiling, is a Gesamtkunstwerk and a magnificent gem of ITE art in the village of Kellosalmi in Padasjoki, some 60 kilometres north of Lahti. The story of the artist, who is known for her colourful paintings and unorthodox lifestyle, lives on in the small red cottage and its mysterious garden.

Seppo Suomensyrjä

Seppo Suomensyrjä is a Formula 1 and motor sports enthusiast. He revisits his own 1950s childhood through real-size toy cars and biplane Sopwith Camel that he has built in his garden.

His toys include a hybrid yellow dragon made from a real Harley, and a Sputnik moped that can be seen speeding against the night-sky. Also, Suomensyrjä designs new spaceage models, Jaguars in particular; he finds the mythology connected to this black beast of the jungle especially fascinating.

Seppo Suomensyrjä has built a Wild West saloon in his own house; it is a warm collection of hilarious objects, a museum of memories. The artist's surreal paintings provide the settings for the gunfights his "cowboy persona" Finn-Side Kid arranges.

To counterbalance the charm of the motorised world, Suomensyrjä has sculpted concrete sprites, elves, Kalevala's Väinämöinen and animals in his back garden.

Leo Laakko & Kari Onninen

Sculpting wood is the most natural form of self-expression among Finnish self-taught artists; the chainsaw is the most common instrument and the bear is the best-loved of all subjects. Leo Laakko and Kari Onninen from Orimattila and Lahti are avid carvers, who participate in the yearly sculpting competitions, such as the Bear Festival in Ilomantsi, Northern Carelia. Together they share a space for carving, entertain guests by sculpting demostrations and display their works in the nearby surroundings.

Kaarilta Art and Activity Center

Kaarisilta is known for its artists and the visionary work it has done as an advocate for the rights of people in need of additional support since 1987. It was the first place in Finland to start providing upper secondary education in visual arts and music in 2003. Kaarisilta Art Studios enable artists and musicians in need of additional support to practise their art professionally. Kaarisilta also runs Art Kaarisilta -gallery in Helsinki.
